Athenea3i is a Fellowship Program enclosed within the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Co-funding of Regional, National and International Programmes (**MSCA-COFUND**) category, 50 % granted by the University of Granada (UGR) and 50% by the European Commission, with a total budget of 4.248.000 euros.

Specifically, the Athenea3i Program has focused on **attracting highly talented researchers to the UGR** in order to benefit their research careers with International, Interdisciplinary and Intersectoral opportunities (Triple 'I').

Thus, this innovative fellowship program has offered experienced researchers of different nationalities an **excellent opportunity** to develop new skills and competences, enriched with a personalized and pioneering career mentoring plan.
