The “**University of Salamanca Programme to Foster Research Excellence (USAL4EXCELLENCE)**” is an initiative of the University of Salamanca (USAL) funded by the Horizon 2020 Programme under MSCA COFUND actions and cofunded by the Junta de Castilla y León, which aims to recruit 40 experienced researchers. Taking a ‘bottom-up’ approach, the overall objective of fellowships will be to recognise the brightest ideas and bring brilliant minds together.

that will enhance their career development and leadership potential.

USAL4EXCELLENCE Fellowship details

Each fellowship will last **30 months**. Fellows will be hosted at USAL and they will have the opportunity and freedom to choose their destination for two secondments. Thus, fellows will have a mandatory period at USAL during the first 24 months, and a mandatory secondment during the last 6 months of the fellowship, as indicated below.

Each fellowship includes funds for travel, research expenses and competitive salary. The total cost of a fellowship is 4.855 €/month and the net salary of the ER will be around 3.500 €/month. The rate indicated above is for researchers working full-time.
