EPFLglobaLeaders is a new EPFL fellowship programme that will support 48 doctoral fellows to become leaders in the transition towards sustainable societies, each with a thesis project addressing at least one of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The programme encourages intersectoral collaborations by mandating a secondment in the non-academic sector.

EPFLglobaLeaders is



a new **international doctoral fellowship programme** funding early stage researchers to become **leaders** in the transition towards **sustainable societies**. Forty-eight doctoral fellows will benefit from a multifaceted training programme, including a secondment in the non-academic sector. They will be enrolled in one of the 21 EPFL doctoral programmes.
