ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



Who can apply for?

- **Researchers** together with a **host organisation**: university, research institution, business, SME or other organisation based in an EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country.
- **All disciplines** are eligible for Postdoctoral Fellowships, including research areas covered by the Euratom Research and Training Programme.



All criteria should be met at the time of call deadline: 10/09/2025

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



Who can apply for?

Researchers interested in PFs:

- Should have a **PhD degree** at the time of the deadline for applications.
- Must have a maximum of **eight years of experience in research** from the date of the award of their PhD degree.
- **Years of experience outside** research and career breaks will not count towards the above maximum, nor will years of experience in research in third countries, for nationals or long-term residents of EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries who wish to reintegrate to Europe.
- Should comply with **mobility rules**: they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary (for European Postdoctoral Fellowships), or the host organisation for the outgoing phase (for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships) for **more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline**.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



Who can apply for?

Researchers interested in PFs:

- ★ As from 2022, **resubmission restrictions** will apply for applications that received a **score below 70% the previous year**.
- ★ **Seals of Excellence** will be awarded to applications with a total score **equal to or higher than 85%**, but which cannot be funded due to lack of budget available under the call.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



PhD degree and maximum 8 years of research full-time experience (FTE) as of 10/09/2025

Exceptions for the 8-year FTE

- ★ Maternal leave: 18 months per child born since the obtaining the PhD degree
- ★ Paternal leave: Exact duration per child born since the obtaining the PhD degree
- ★ Long-term sick leave
- ★ Career breaks
- ★ Time not devoted to research
- ★ National service
- ★ Nationals and long-term residents of MS&AC in a TC or having returned to Europe along the last 12 months before the call deadline, can discount their research experience in TCs when applying to EUROPEAN FELLOWSHIPS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



Since 1 January 2024, UK researchers have been able to participate in the programme on the same terms as researchers from EU Member States, which means they have direct access to Horizon Europe funding, including the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA).

Organisations based in the UK are able to participate as beneficiaries in the same terms as those based in the European Union and countries already associated to Horizon Europe.

The association will apply to MSCA calls for proposals launched as of 2025.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



For MSCA, this means UK institutions:

- are eligible as a host for the European Fellowships
- are eligible as an incoming host for Global Fellowships
- are eligible as a host for secondments and non-academic placements
- are not eligible as an outgoing host for Global Fellowships

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



With the signing of a transitional agreement between the EU and Switzerland, **new rules will apply to Swiss institutions in Horizon Europe as of 1 January 2025**: Swiss institutions can apply as **beneficiaries for the MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2025 call**. It is no longer possible to involve a Swiss institution as a host for a Global Fellowship during the outgoing phase. Switzerland is to be fully associated from 2025, subject to the signing and validation of the corresponding agreement by both parties. However, transitional arrangements will allow Swiss applicants to participate in the calls for proposals of the 2025 programme year.

EUROPEAN FELLOWSHIP (EF)

Host Institution: in a MS or AC

- **Open to all nationalities**
- **Mobility rule:** Max. 12 months of the last 36 months in the European country of the Beneficiary as of 10/09/2025
- Researcher with **PhD degree** and **max. 8 years of research FTE** as of 10/09/2025
- Project implemented in a European organization (beneficiary)
- Duration from 12 to 24 months
- **Secondments** can take place in **any part of the world** (max. $\frac{1}{3}$ of the duration of the project)
- Possibility of 6-month extension for a non-academic placement in Europe

GLOBAL FELLOWSHIP (GF)

Host Institution: in MS or AC

Associated Partner: Third Country (TC)



- **Outgoing phase** outside Europe (Third Country, 12-24 months - Associated Partner) and **return phase in Europe**, in the beneficiary (12 months)
- **Researchers from MS or AC, and long-term residents (+5 years)**
- Researcher with **PhD degree** and **max. 8 years of research FTE** as of 10/09/2025
- **Mobility rule:** Max. 12 months of the last 36 months in the country of the **outgoing phase** as of 10/09/2025
- Duration from 24 to 36 months (incl. 12 month return phase)
- **Secondments** can take place in **any part of the world** (only during outgoing phase and max. 1/3 of the duration of the outgoing phase)
- Possibility of 6-month extension for a non-academic placement in Europe

If you have lived/studied/worked **in Spain** for more than 12 months in the last 3 years, you **CAN** request the **MSCA PF GF** in a Spanish institution. You cannot have lived/studied/worked for more than 12 months in the last 3 years at the **OP country** (USA, Japan ...)

AWARD CRITERIA



- ❖ Applications will be evaluated by experts, based on the evaluation criteria **"excellence", "impact" and "quality and efficiency of implementation"**.
- ❖ For each of these evaluation criteria a score out of 5 will be awarded. The scores will be subject to a weighting factor:

Evaluation criteria	Percentage	Priority
Excellence	50 %	1
Impact	30 %	2
Implementation	20 %	3

- ❖ Applications scoring $\geq 70\%$ will be considered for funding, within the limits of the budget available for the call. All other applications will be rejected.


- **Full time**
- **Long-term allowance:** personnel costs incurred by the beneficiaries in case of researchers' leave, including maternity, paternity, parental, sick or special leave –during the project life-time
- **Special needs allowance:** additional costs for the acquisition of special needs items and services for researchers with disabilities (up to 60 000€ per researcher) -during the project life-time

MSCA PF FINANCIAL ASPECTS



To obtain the **net salary**, (final income of the researcher paid by the employer), the following calculations need to be done:

1. From the total amount of granted money dedicated to cover the **cost of researchers**, employer's contribution to the Spanish welfare system and redundancy payment is subtracted, the rest is dedicated to **gross salary** (amount reflected in the payslip). The **redundancy payment** will be given back to you at the finalization of the MSCA funded period.
2. From the **gross salary**, employee's contribution and taxes are withheld, obtaining the **net salary** (final income of the researcher).

Amount assigned to the institution:

❖ Research, training and networking costs: **€ 1.000**

Training and networking activities that directly contribute to the career development of researchers:

- participation in conferences
- action-related travel, training, language courses, seminars
- training, language courses, seminars
- laboratory equipment, books, library records, publication costs, etc.

Research costs, fees and visas, travel and accommodation costs, etc.

❖ Management and indirect costs: **€ 650**

Additional costs of the beneficiary related to the management of the project.



Keys for preparing the proposals



Much more than a research project

- Develop research capacity (related to the scientific project, leading to stronger research skills and advances in the research field)
- Develop transferable skills and employability
- Exchange of knowledge between researcher (fellow), supervisors and participating organizations

A common approach

- The best proposals are always collaborative **between the candidate researcher, the organization presenting the proposal, and the assigned supervisor**
- The supervisor as a key role in the proposal
- All parties should collaborate to establish expectations and reach
- Keep in mind the needs of the project and of the researcher applying











TAKE-HOME MESSAGES



- Your proposal is not a research proposal as such, but a proposal for training in research
- The weighting of criteria is 50% - 30% - 20%. You need to perform at close to 100% on each
- Your employability after the fellowship is key
- Your CV doesn't have to be perfect, but the training should mend any shortcomings
- Follow the template –the evaluators need to find all key points
- You cannot start too early on drafting your proposal
- The Guide for Applicants is a must-read
- Don't be over-ambitious –it is a common flaw that the work plan is not realistic
- Don't be boring
- Your reviewers may not be specialists in your field
- There may be exceptions from our advice –seek help from people with experience!
